

## **John Shellenberger**

John has been an employee of the First Judicial District (FJD) of Pennsylvania for nine years. He holds a degree in The Administration of Justice from Pennsylvania State University and has actively studied in the field of court management from the National Center for State Court's Institute for Court Management. Since 2004, Mr. Shellenberger has held positions in the Offices of the Prothonotary, Civil Administration, and the Clerk of Courts of Philadelphia. John has participated in a broad range of projects, often entailing the use of technology, to promote efficiencies for both internal and external users of the courts.

In 2007 John assisted in development, implementation, and user training aspects of the FJD Civil eFiling project. Currently, electronic users comprise nearly all of the filing traffic, totaling approximately one thousand filings per day. John serves on the Criminal Document Management System and Criminal eFiling teams. These initiatives have improved access to information in the criminal system and have nearly eliminated the need for paper case files in courtrooms. John has also co-managed the development of the eCommerce system, which allows non-parties to preview and purchase case documents online. He most recently served as Project Manager of The Civil Electronic Subpoena Initiative, which was executed in spring of 2013. John currently serves as a Senior Staff Advisor to the District Court Administrator of the FJD, Joseph H. Evers.
