AND NOW, this **10th** day of November, 2008, in order to reserve judicial resources as well as the resources of the parties, the Court on its own motion now stays all Hormone Replacement Therapy matters in which summary judgment motions are pending (either answered or unanswered) and further stays the filing of any summary judgment motion in the future. The matters now being stayed are limited to those cases which contain Statute of Limitation issues based upon *Coleman v. Wyeth* (and related cases consolidated for appeal), the appeal of which is now pending in the Pennsylvania Superior Court. Once the *Coleman* matter is resolved, the Court will immediately status the matter for appropriate action.

The parties are directed to confer for the purposes of identifying all matters affected by this stay and provide the list to the Court within fifteen (15) days.
