



CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 6
(AMENDING TRIAL CASE SELECTION DATE)

AND NOW, this 5th day of May, 2009, it is hereby ORDERED that paragraph II.B.1. of Case Management Order No. 2 (Amended) is amended to read as follows:

(1) **Manner of Exchange of Selections.** Liaison Counsel shall exchange their respective lists of three (3) selections by email at noon Eastern time on **July 15, 2009**. I have enclosed for Your Honor's review proposed Case Management Order No. 6, which has been agreed to by all parties.

The purpose of this proposed Case Management Order is to amend Case Management Order No. 2 to move the date for trial case selections from June 1, 2009, to July 15, 2009. This change will not affect any other deadline in this litigation, including trial dates. The purpose of the amendment is simply to allow the parties some additional time in which evaluate and review cases for trial selection purposes. That process includes depositions of important witnesses, as well as other discovery, and the scheduling of medical witnesses has been cumbersome. The parties believe that the proposed extension will allow for a reasonable amount of time in which to complete the needed pre-selection discovery, evaluate cases and make rational and intelligent trial case selections.

If the enclosed Order meets with Your Honor's approval, the parties respectfully request that you execute it and arrange for it to be filed of record.
