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**MOTION TO ADD ADDITIONAL PLAINTIFFS' LIAISON COUNSEL**

1. On July 15, 2008, this Honorable Court entered Case Management Order No. 1 in the Trasylol litigation, and in paragraph II (a) appointed James R. Ronca and Sol Weiss of Anapol Schwartz as Plaintiffs' liaison counsel.

2. As discussed with the Court at the last status conference on May 18, 2010, the Trasylol litigation has matured and trials will begin in the fall of 2010. Therefore, Plaintiffs' liaison counsel requests that the Court appoint, as co-liaison counsel, two lawyers who have been deeply involved in the litigation, both on the state and national level.

3. Liaison counsel proposes that Scott Love, Esquire of Clark, Dean & Burnett in Houston, Texas, be appointed as co-liaison counsel in this case. Mr. Love has been involved in the Trasylol litigation from its inception and is currently the co-lead counsel of the multi-district litigation relating to Trasylol. Mr. Love has been intensely involved in all common benefit work, including depositions of Defendants' employees and preparation and defending depositions of Plaintiffs' experts. Mr. Love has numerous cases filed in the Philadelphia litigation.

4. Plaintiffs also propose, to be named as co-liaison counsel, David Matthews, Esquire of Houston, Texas. Mr. Matthews is on the Plaintiffs' Steering Committee of the multi-district litigation on Trasyolol and has been directly involved in depositions, expert preparation, and trial preparation in both the state and federal litigation. Mr. Matthews has numerous cases filed in Pennsylvania.

5. Both Mr. Matthews and Mr. Love have been admitted pro hac vice for this litigation and have previously appeared in other litigations before the Pennsylvania courts. In particular, Mr. Love was involved in the Paxil litigation, and Mr. Matthews in the Avandia litigation.

6. Defense has no objection to Plaintiffs' request.


