



CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2

(Additional Authorizations)



**I. PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING BLANK AUTHORIZATIONS**

This Case Management Order (CMO) governs the process for obtaining additional blank authorizations from Plaintiffs.

In each case in which Plaintiff is serving a Plaintiff's Fact Sheet (PFS) pursuant to CMO 1, Plaintiff will provide an additional seven (7) original signed blank authorizations to Defendants' Liaison Counsel. Upon the discovery of specific providers not previously identified by Plaintiff in the PFS, Defendants shall have the right to use the blank authorization(s) to request records. In addition, Defendants shall have the right to copy the original seven (7) authorizations as necessary to procure records. Plaintiffs will also designate up to two (2) persons upon whom Defendants' counsel will provide notice of intent to use the authorizations as outlined infra. The designation by Plaintiffs' counsel shall include the name, fax number, phone number and email address of the designee(s). If Plaintiffs' counsel fails to designate a person upon whom service should be made, service to counsel of record for Plaintiff will suffice.

Prior to using a blank authorization, Defendants shall provide written notice to the person(s) designated by Plaintiffs' counsel, as outlined above, via electronic mail and fax, of the name/address of the holder of the records from whom Defendants intend to request records. Within seven (7) business days of the service of the request, Plaintiffs' counsel shall notify


Defendants by electronic mail that they object to use of the blank authorization to request said records from the specified holder of the records. If no objection is made within the seven (7) day period, Defendants may immediately serve the authorization on the holder of the records specified in the written notice.

Plaintiffs and Defendants may agree to additional time. Defendants reserve the right to request additional authorizations as may be necessary. All authorizations for mental health records are specifically excluded from this CMO.
