CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 1(c)
(Preliminary Objections to First Amended Master Long Form Complaint)

This Order supplements *Case Management Order No. 1* regarding the time for Plaintiff to respond or otherwise plead in response to Defendants' Master Preliminary Objections.

On March 30, 2010, by and through their attorney Albert G. Bixler of Eckert Seamans Cherin & Melott, LLC, the Bayer Defendants filed Master Preliminary Objections to Plaintiffs' First Amended Master Long Form Complaint ("Bayer's' Master POs") (Plaintiffs' response due April 29, 2010). On April 9, 2010, by and through Mr. Bixler, the Barr-Teva defendants separately filed the POs as the Bayer Master POs (Plaintiffs' response due May 10, 2010).

To eliminate duplication of effort so that the Court can consider at one time both Bayer and Barr-Teva's Master POs, **IT IS**, on this 19th day of April, 2010, upon stipulation and consent of the Parties, hereby **ORDERED** that:


- 1) the date for Plaintiffs to respond or otherwise plead to *both* the Bayer and the Barr-Teva Master POs is on or before May 10, 2010;
