CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2
GENERAL DISCOVERY AND PRE-TRIAL ORDER

J. STEWART

As part of this Court’s continuing effort to secure the just, speedy, and cost-effective determination of the Risperdal-Risperidone Cases, and to eliminate duplication of effort, prevent unnecessary paperwork and promote judicial economy, the Court hereby enters this Second Case Management Order.

I. DISCOVERY

1. Prior to the close of business on June __, 2010, counsel for the Johnson & Johnson defendants shall identify to Plaintiff’s counsel all documents that have been produced heretofore in other Risperdal personal injury litigation that they are voluntarily willing to produce in the instant litigation. Further, counsel for the Johnson & Johnson defendants shall identify to Plaintiff’s counsel all other personal injury, as well as all other reasonably related pending, litigation, and provide a written basis for not voluntarily producing documents that have been produced in those cases.

2. The following deadlines shall apply for the completion of discovery and the exchange of expert reports:

- Fact discovery complete 24 weeks before trial
- Plaintiffs’ Generic Expert Reports 21 weeks prior to trial


- Defendants' Generic Expert Reports 17 weeks prior to trial
- Generic Expert Depositions Completed 15 weeks prior to trial
- Plaintiffs' Case-Specific Expert Reports¹ 16 weeks prior to trial
- Defendants' Case-Specific Expert Reports² 14 weeks prior to trial
- Dispositive Motions (other than Frye)³ 14 weeks prior to trial
- Frye Motions 13 weeks prior to trial
- Frye Hearings 9 weeks prior to trial

II. PRETRIAL

The following deadlines shall apply to pretrial proceedings other than identified above:

- Pretrial Memorandum 6 weeks prior to trial
- Pretrial/Settlement Conference 5 weeks prior to trial
- Motions *in Limine* 4 weeks prior to trial
- Deposition designations, witness and exhibit lists 3 weeks prior to trial
- *Voir dire* 2 weeks prior to trial
- Counter designations 1 week prior to trial
- Jury charge and verdict form 1 week prior to trial
- Jury selection Thursday before trial
