## C. ECONOMIC HARDSHIP REQUESTS (Ordinary Transcripts Only)

1) Cases on Appeal or Transcripts needed to advance litigation

a. IFP Status or Litigant's income within 125% of poverty line: No Charge

b. Litigant's income within 200% of poverty line: Reduced by 50%

2) Transcript Not Necessary to Advance Litigation: litigant must file a <u>Petition for Waiver of Transcript Costs</u> as provided by rules of court if a waiver of costs is requested

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>#</sup>As required by Pa.R.A.P. 1922 (b), the court reporter or transcriptionist shall transcribe the entire proceedings when transcripts are requested in connection with an appeal or cross-appeal, unless an order for diminution of transcription has been issued in civil case by the trial court or pursuant to Pa.R.Crim.P. 115 in criminal cases.

<sup>\*</sup>Unless transcript fees are waived, Delivery Time commences to run upon receipt of the required deposit from Requestor.

<sup>+</sup>Real-Time transcripts provided in the courtroom during a proceeding are not certified. At the conclusion of the proceeding a certified transcript will be prepared and filed as required.
