

- Box 7: If you live in one of the following counties: Allegheny, Beaver, Berks, Blair, Bucks, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Delaware, Erie, Lackawanna, Lancaster, Lehigh, Luzerne, Mercer, Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, Washington, Westmoreland, or York, you must call your county's Court Administrator's Office, Prothonotary's Office, or other related county office to determine what lawyer referral service to put by box 7.

If you do NOT live in one of the above listed counties: Write by box 7: "Pennsylvania Bar Association – Lawyer Referral Service Telephone 1-800-692-7375 (PA only) or 717-238-6715"

- Box 8: Print the name of the county you filed in exactly as you wrote on Form 1.
- Box 9: Print Plaintiff's name exactly as is appears on Form 1.
- Box 10: Print the docket number that the Prothonotary's Office wrote on Form 1 at the time of filing.
- Box 11: Print Defendant's name exactly as is appears on Form 1.
- Box 12: Leave blank.
- Box 13: Leave blank.




