All settlement conference memoranda and/or pre-trial conference memoranda presented in the Major Non-Jury and Arbitration Appeal Programs *must* be filed no later than ten (10) days prior to the date of the scheduled conference.

In accordance with the Notice to the Bar regarding the expansion of the Civil Electronic Filing System (effective July 20, 2015), conference memoranda can now be filed electronically with the Court within the existing case section of the Civil Electronic Filing System under the filing category "Conference Submissions." It is important to note, electronically filed memoranda also *must* be filed no later than ten (10) days prior to the date of the scheduled conference.

Any attorney or party who fails to timely file a pretrial settlement conference memorandum in accordance with the Case Management Order and this Notice will be subject to the imposition of sanctions as deemed appropriate by this Court.
