## **ORDER**

AND NOW, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024, in anticipation of a possible strike by SEPTA employees commencing on November 8, 2024 at 12:01a.m., and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that – in the event that a strike by SEPTA employees occurs:

- 1. All arbitrations, jury and non-jury trials in which SEPTA is a party or a SEPTA employee represented by SEPTA counsel is a party will be continued for the duration of the strike and four days after the strike ends;
- 2. All Orders issued in matters where SEPTA is a party or a SEPTA employee represented by SEPTA counsel is a party are stayed during the pendency of the strike and for twenty days thereafter; and
- 3. In matters where SEPTA is a party or a SEPTA employee represented by SEPTA counsel is a party, no default for failure to answer a Complaint, Petition or Motion, or to comply with a discovery Order will be issued for the duration of the strike and twenty days thereafter.

This Order is issued in accordance with Pa.R.C.P. No. 239 and April 11, 1986 Order of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania Eastern District, No. 55 Judicial Administration and shall become effective immediately. The original Order shall be filed with the Office of Judicial Records, Civil in a Docket maintained for Administrative Orders issued by the Administrative Judge of the Trial Division, Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County, and shall be submitted to the Pennsylvania Bulletin for publication. Copies of the Order shall be submitted to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, the Civil Procedural Rules Committee, The Legal Intelligencer, Jenkins Memorial Library, and the Law Library for the First Judicial District of Pennsylvania, and shall be posted on the website of the First Judicial District of Pennsylvania: <a href="http://www.courts.phila.gov/regs">http://www.courts.phila.gov/regs</a>.
